

Our Mission Statement:

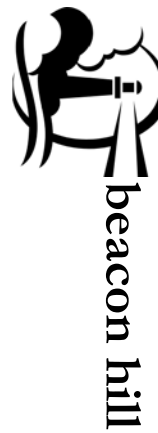
Provide a temporary home, life skills, & mentorship to Anchorage's homeless women and children through the love of Christ.

Who We Are:

Beacon Hill is a 3 to 6 month temporary housing facility that serves a portion of Anchorage's most vulnerable, yet most likely to become self-sufficient single moms with children who are

- motivated
- employed
- sober
- willing to participate in mentoring relationships

Beacon Hill is made up of 2 large homes in Anchorage that sit on 2 acres of land, which have been remodeled into 5 separate living areas. These 5 apartments are home to 4-5 Guest residents and 1 Resident Manager.



FAQ's:

Q: What does Beacon Hill offer?

A: Beacon Hill has 4 fully furnished Guest units in apartment-style living. Each Guest home has: attractively decorated bedrooms, private restroom in each unit, private dining areas, safe, warm living areas, television with a DVD and/or VHS player. Additionally, there are common laundry facilities on-site, large shared kitchen areas, an over-sized indoor kid's playroom, 2 acres of fully landscaped yard, a lot of privacy. Each Guest will have professional case management and an assigned Support Family to help transition into complete self-sufficiency.

Q: How does a homeless mother with children get a home at Beacon Hill?

A: Each Guest family must be referred by a church, non-profit agency or government agency. Once an application is received for a potential Guest, eligibility will be determined on a case-by-case basis through a point system. Beacon Hill is not currently equipped to handle high lethality domestic violence case.

Q: How much does it cost to stay at BH?

A: The sliding monthly guest fee is \$250 for the 1st month, \$350 for the 2nd month and \$500 for the 3rd month - this can be paid by the Guest or the Referring Agency. Stays at Beacon Hill are 3 months with extensions available on a month-to-month basis.

Q: Who is in charge of Beacon Hill?

A: Beacon Hill has an active board of directors and a management team that is responsible for guest decisions. Additionally, Beacon Hill is sustained by many wonderful volunteers compelled by the love of Jesus to see their community changed.

Q: How can you be involved?
