PRESERVE FAMILIES



**Safe Families for children -**  
*A compassionate response when families face crisis*

Safe Families for Children provided **184 short-term, voluntary hostings** for children whose families were navigating crisis—preventing unnecessary foster care placements and keeping families intact. Each hosting represents a moment when a family said, “We need help,” and the community answered, “You are not alone.”



**Family Support Services -**  
*Preserving families through connection and consistency*

Beacon Hill’s Family Support Services focus on strengthening relationships between children and their families while reducing trauma during separation. In our two family support centers, we provided **1,787 hours of meaningful family contact and connection.** Additionally, **22 newly trained community volunteers**, who are passionate about strengthening and supporting local families, provided **207 of those hours .**

PREPARE FUTURES



**Permanency -**  
*Helping children find forever families*

Beacon Hill worked tirelessly to ensure children didn’t remain in limbo. **91 people** attended our Adopting Through Foster Care Orientation, **13 youth** were supported by SEEN mentors to help them process their trauma and prepare for adoption, and **6 children found their forever home.**



After over **3,900 days** in care, David found his **Forever Family!**

PROVIDE HOPE



**Beacon Hill Boutique -**  
*Offering practical help with dignity*

Through the sole power of community donations, **1,678 children** and **1,492 adults** were provided essential items such as clothing, winter gear, and hygiene supplies at a value of **\$133,142.** This meant that **845 foster, kinship, and struggling families** shopped for what they needed—free of charge and without stigma.



**CarePortal -**  
*Care sharing technology, connecting the local church to local needs*

Through CarePortal, churches and community partners responded to real-time needs from child-serving agencies, providing essential items such as beds and groceries for **191 children** and **111 adults**, making an economic impact of **\$70,161.**
